Altar Servers MUST be:

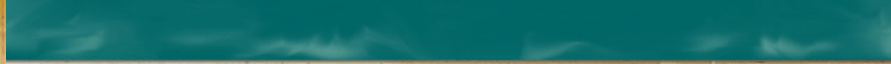
- in 4th grade or up
